Wireless Access

Wireless Access is available throughout the Library. You can check email, surf the Internet, browse the library catalog, download files, and print directly from your laptop.

General Information:

- Service is available on a best effort basis.
- Due to security on our network some ports or functions may be disabled.
- Indian Trails Public Library reserves the right to deny service based on user, equipment or location.
- All configuration of wireless equipment connecting to the Library's wireless network is the responsibility of the user.
- Users accept responsibility for the security of their equipment. The Library does not provide software or hardware support.
- If you need to connect your laptop to an electrical outlet please seek assistance from the staff.

Laptop Settings:

- The network is based on Wi-Fi compatible 802.11b equipment. Set your laptop to use Automatic DHCP.
- Connect to the ITPLD Wireless Access Point (WAP).
- If you use wireless networking at home or at your place of work you may need to setup a new profile for use with our network. Consult the documentation that came with your wireless network card for more information.
- When you open your web browser, our Internet Use Policy page will load. Please read through the policy. You must click "I Agree" before you can browse the Internet.

Printing:

- To print, you must install a new local printer on your laptop. Use an HP LaserJet Driver model 1300N or compatible printer driver, a standard TCP/IP port, and one of the following IP addresses:
