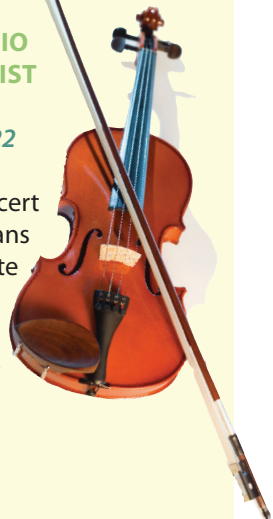


LINCOLN TRIO YOUNG ARTIST SERIES

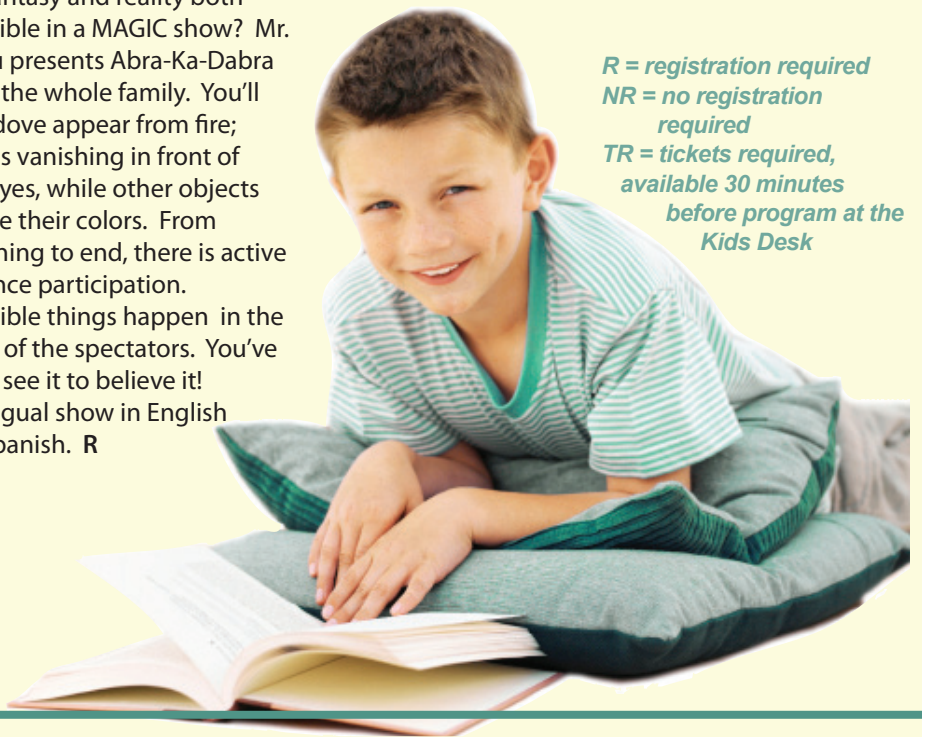
