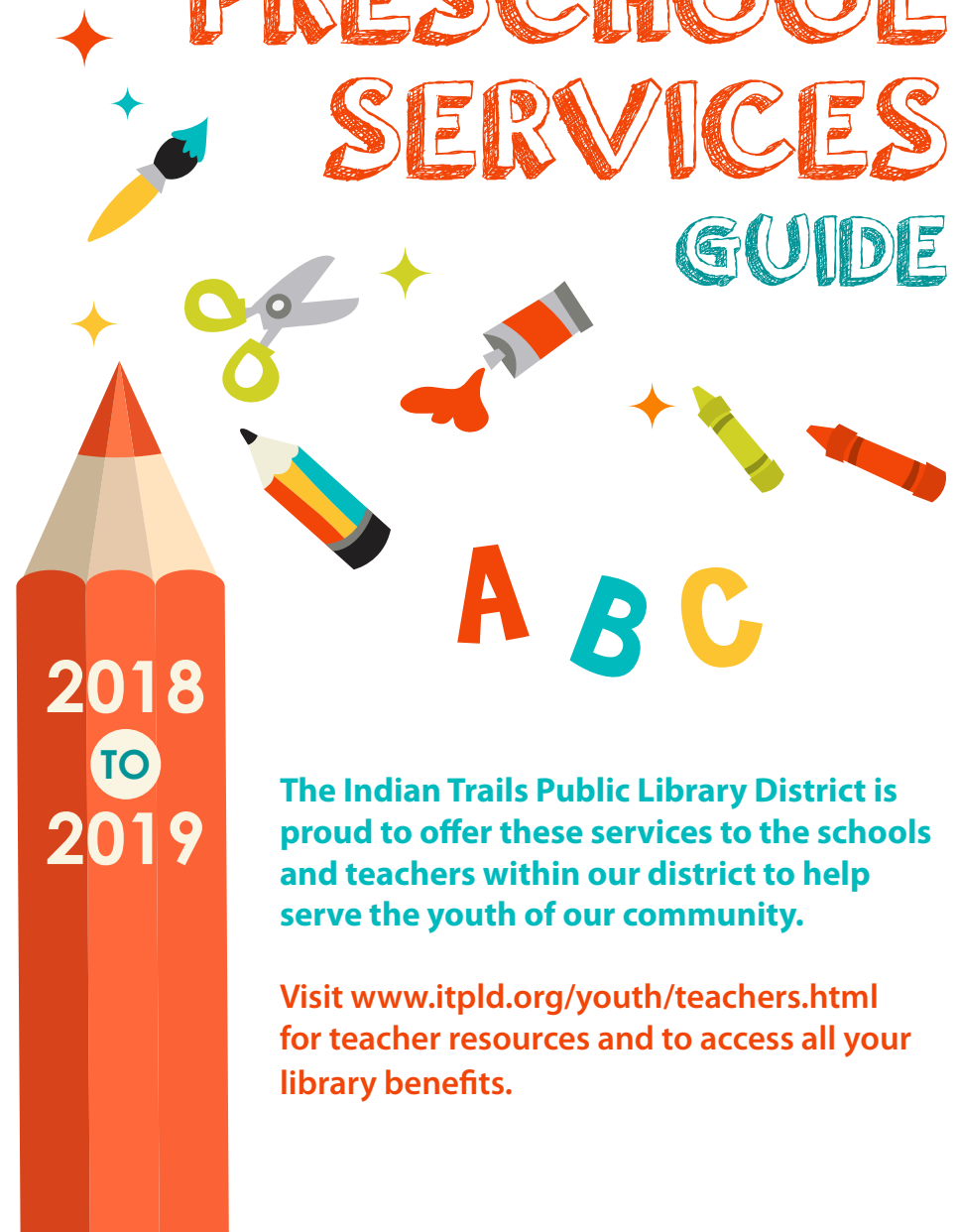

Bookbags, filled with up to 30 items on any subject (depending on availability), may be requested for classroom use. One bookbag may be checked out at a time, for six weeks using a school library card. Please allow up to five school days for your request to be filled.
