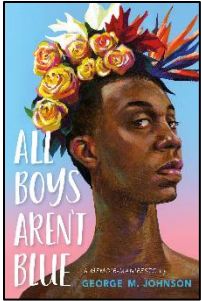

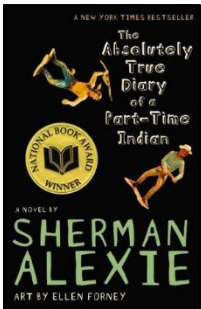

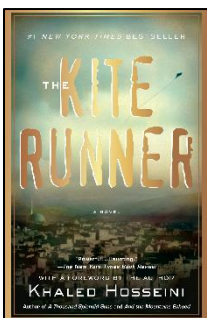


[The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian](#)

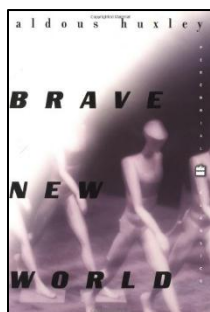

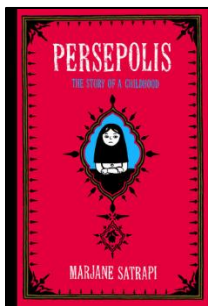
