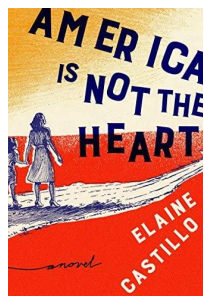

Below are recommendations for books with English and at least one other language.



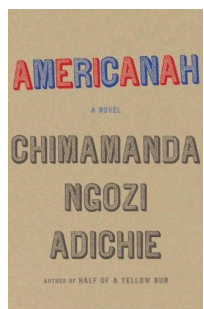
