Kindle Paperwhite Basics

Power Switch - Press and hold the bottom u button to turn the device on or off. To put the device to sleep, push and release the power button.

USB/Power Port - Use the USB cable to connect to the wall charger or computer.

Connecting to your Kindle

You must login with your amazon information or Kindle app to use the ITPLD Kindle Paperwhites

- Through Kindle App
 - Register via bluetooth through the Kindle app on your device
 - Follow the directions on the screen
- Username and password
 - Enter amazon username and password
 - You might need to go to amazon.com/code to verify

Once connected it will make you go through a set up process. Say no or not now to avoid putting in any credit card information.

Reading a Book

To read a library book you will need to go through the Libby app or on your computer through overdrive with your Indian Trails Library Card and PIN

- Once you have found the book you want to read, find it on your Home page or Library at the bottom of the screen
- Tap on Book
- Enjoy!

Increase size or other settings

- Tap towards the top of the page and there should be settings on the top and the page count on the bottom
- Select Aa
 - Themes
 - Large will increase the size, you can see what it looks towards the top of the screen
 - Font



Kindle Paperwhite Basics

- You can change the Font Family to a more desired font or an OpenDyslexic is on there
- Bold
- Increase size
- Layout
 - Change the orientation
 - Alignment
 - Margins
 - Spacing
- More
 - Reading progress
 - You can change what your reading progress looks like if you want the page in the book, location, or none.
 - Show clock while reading is automatically turned off, turn that on if you would like to see the time
- When done customizing size and settings, tap towards top of screen
