Visit ITPLD's makerspace, the Launch Pad to learn, create, explore, play and collaborate. The Launch Pad is a space for all ages.



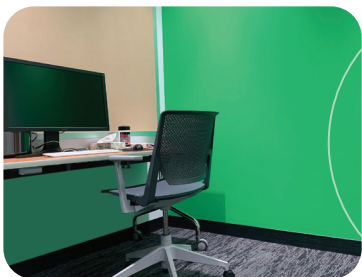
DIGITAL MEDIA LABS

- Find or create 3D files and send them to print

Epilog Mini Laser Cutter

- Engrave onto glass, wood, acrylic and more
- Cut wood, acrylic and more (3/8" thick maximum)

Silhouette Vinyl Cutter

- Cut intricate designs out of cardstock, vinyl, heat transfer vinyl and more

Janome Magnolia sewing machines

- Sew your projects

Brother Embroidery machines

- Embroider text and designs onto fabric

AccuQuilt Go Big

- Die cut fabric shapes; useful for quilters.

Button/Magnet maker

- Create your own buttons and magnets

Sizzix Die Cut machines

- Use a variety of dies to cut paper and cardstock for a range of uses
