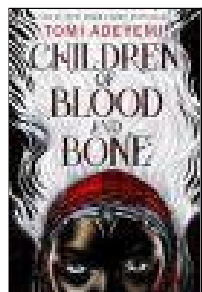

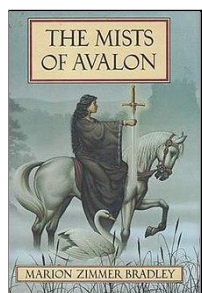
Below are recommendations for fantasy books. Find one that sounds interesting and check it out!
