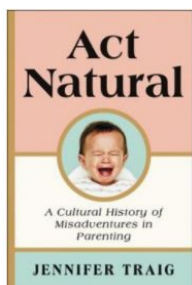

Below are recommendations for books that are funny. Find one that you think will make you laugh out loud and check it out!

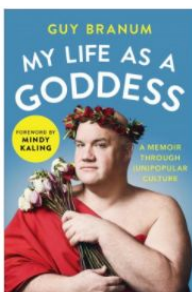

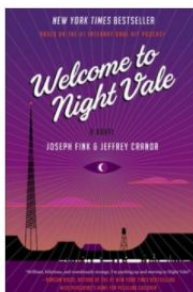

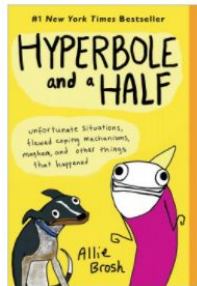


Shades of Grey

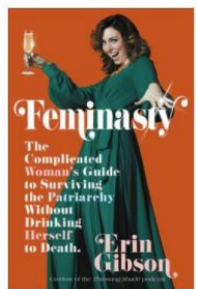


Hyperbole and a Half

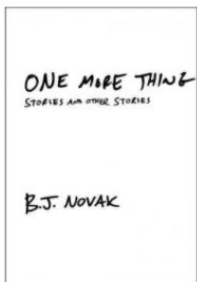

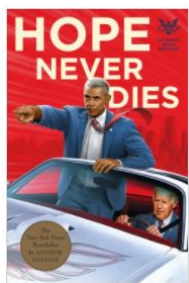
