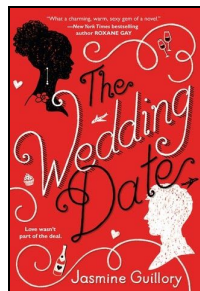

Below are books that library staff recommend. Find one that looks interesting and check it out!

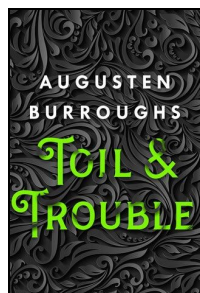


### ***The Wedding Date***

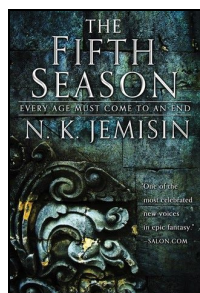


### ***Ask Again, Yes***

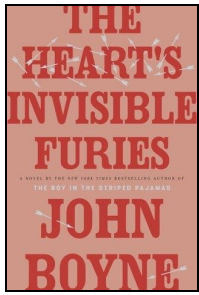
### ***The Fifth Season***

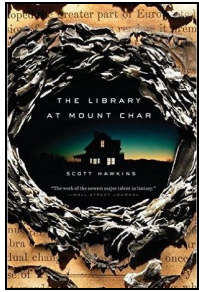


***The Heart's Invisible Furies***

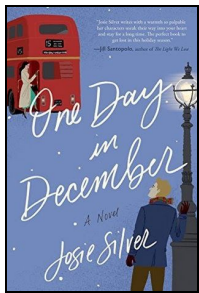


***The Library at Mount Char***

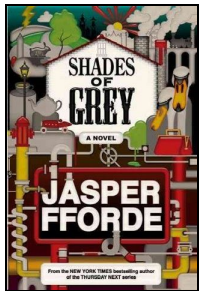


***One Day in December***

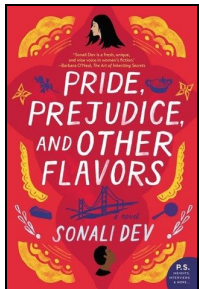


***Shades of Grey***
