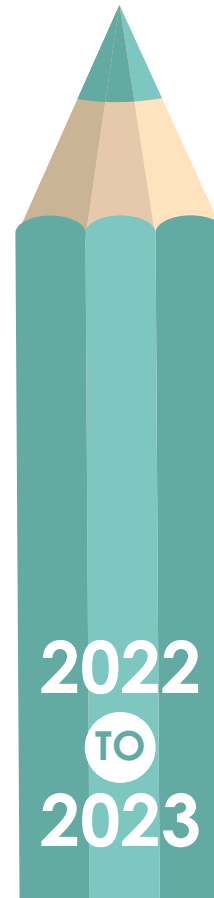

Bring your class to the library for a behind-the-scenes tour, research help and/or checking out books. Please give at least two weeks notice to book a tour.

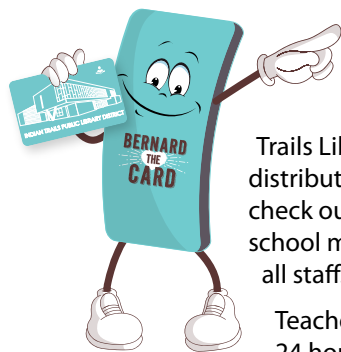
