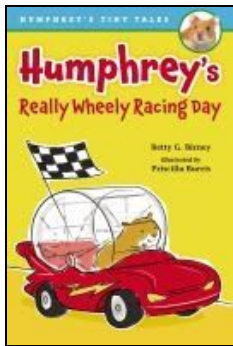

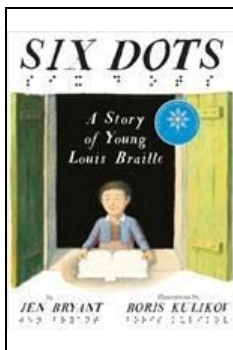


## [Humphrey's Really Wheely Racing Day](#)

**Description:** When Many brings a special hamster-sized racecar to class, it means just one thing - Humphrey is going to be in a hamster race.

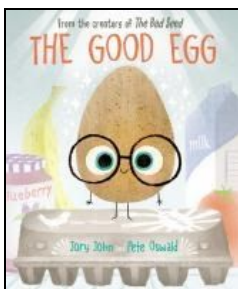


## [Six Dots: A Story of Young Louis Braille](#)

**Description:** A dog who insists she is a wolf finds the perfect home with a young girl who sees past her prickly personality.



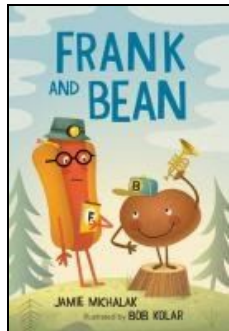


### [Dewdrop](#)

**Description:** Frank likes peace and quiet. Bean likes noise. But Bean is missing something: he does not have words. Will Frank will share his words?

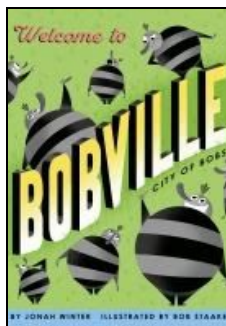


### [The Lost Book](#)

**Description:** All rabbits love books, except for Henry; he prefers games and adventures. Then he reads one special book and someone special finds him.

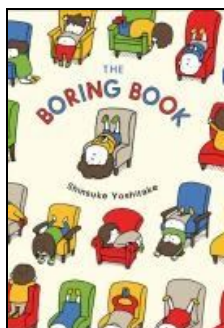


### [Welcome to Bobville: City of Bobs](#)
